The Eastern Zone announced the framework for the [March Sectional Meet](#) in Christiansburg, VA. To allow for greater participation, this year's meet will be timed finals. Details will follow on the [Eastern Zone website](#) when available.

In lieu of a Zone Age Group Meet this spring, the Eastern Zone is running an age group leaderboard. Any times for 14&U swimmers in the Eastern Zone swum during the months of February and March will be eligible for inclusion on the leaderboard which will reside on the [Eastern Zone website](#).

PVS is working out the final details and meet announcements for the [March Championship Series](#). The goal of the Spring 2021 PVS Championship meets is to offer a single opportunity to as many PVS swimmers as possible to have a championship meet experience. **As a result, swimmers are only allowed to participate in one short course championship meet in the month of March.** This includes meets inside and outside of Potomac Valley Swimming, e.g., NCSA Spring Champs, NCSA Age Group Champs, ISCA Senior Cup, ISCA Elite Showcase Classic, and Sectionals.
