Awards:	Ribbons will be awarded from first-sixteenth place for individual events. Ribbons for first- fourth place for relay events. Heat awards will be given to the winner of each individual heat.		
Eligibility:	Open to all Potomac Valley Swimming registered athletes and invited USS athletes and teams. All clubs and athletes must be in good standing with USA Swimming and their respective LSC. Entries accepted on a first come first serve basis with priority given to clubs entered last year. It may be necessary to limit entries due to time constraints. Athletes shall compete at the age attained on the first day of meet.		
Rules:	Current United States Swimming rules shall govern the meet. All events are timed finals. A contestant may enter no more than three (3) individual events per day .		
Warm ups:	The prescribed PVS Warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. There will be two 30 minute warm-up sessions. Teams will be notified of their warm-up assignments.		
Admission:	There is no admission charge. Programs for each session will be available for \$1.00 each. Working officials and coaches receive a free program.		
Officials:	Officials assigned to this meet should sign in at the recording table 10 minutes before the start of the warm-ups. Certified officials who have not been contacted and would like to volunteer should contact Dennis Meyer at (703) 876-4099 <u>d2meyer@hotmail.com</u> or speak with the deck referee at the meet.		
Timers:	The host club will provide at least one timer per lane. Participating clubs are requested to provide one timer every session the team participates in.		
Deck Entries:	Deck entries are \$10.00 per individual event and must be submitted no later then 15 minutes prior to the first event of each session. No new heats will be created. First come, first served.		
Special Note:	SPECIAL HOLIDAY MEET T-SHIRTS AND PATCHES WILL BE AVAILABLE IN LIMITED QUANTITIES.		

MEET ENTRY PROCEDURES:

General Instructions: Entries may be submitted (1) manually, (2) by disk, (3) via email. The following general instructions apply regardless of method chosen.

ALL ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY 5:00PM, TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 27, 2001

- Relays Relay cards go directly to the timer in your assigned lane. For award purposes, *PRINT CLEARLY* on the back the names of the relay members.
- Entries not submitted on the required forms, not complete, not legible or not in the required electronic format, will not be accepted and will be returned.
- Any club that enters an unregistered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100.00; no further entries will be accepted from the club/team until said fine has been paid.

⇒ Manual Entries

- For unattached swimmers not affiliated with a USA Swimming club, entries must be provided manually. Provide a list of events, times (if applicable), copy of USS Registration card, contact info., and a check for the total amount of the entries.
- Manual entries from clubs must be submitted on the PVS master entry sheet. Also submit a completed "entry cover sheet". Signature and phone number of a club official must be included with entry for validation of entries. Teams entering 10 or more athletes in this format will need to pay a \$1.00 surcharge per swimmer.
- Forward to the address listed above in the General Instructions.

⇒ Disk Entries

- Submit the Hy-Tek commlink II file with an "<u>entry cover sheet</u>". Attach the team manager meet entry report files, one by swimmer and one by event. Include the name, phone number, and email address of club representative submitting the disk.
- Forward to the address listed above in the General Instructions.

⇒ E-mail Entries

- E-mail entries need to be zipped.
- Attach commlink file of entries. Include a meet entry report by swimmer and a meet entry report by event. Create these reports in Team Manager and save as Word for Windows files.
- In body of e-mail, give entry numbers (girls, boys, relays, total) and contact information (e-mail, phone, officials contact).
- Submit entries to the Meet Manager, George Massey, <u>mailto:coachmassey@hotmail.com</u>. In the subject heading please indicate "2001 Reindeer Mini ****" with the club's initials substituted in place of the asterisks.
