Clubs are responsible for providing their fair share of timers, and required number of timers will be assigned by the meet director. There will be no electronic timing at this meet; watch times only. Each lane MUST have 3 timers at all times, no exceptions.

- 10 lane, 25-yard pool, with non-turbulent lane lines and continuous flow-through gutters.
- Water depth is 17' in lane 1 and 6'9" in lane 10 at the starting end and 13'5" at the turning end.
- The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C, and is on file with USAS
- Manual timing (stopwatches only) will be used for this meet.

O Warm-ups: 8:15 AM

Event Start: 9:00 AM

Warm-Up Procedures: The prescribed Potomac Valley Swimming warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed.

Deck Access: All PVS/USAS registered coaches and deck officials are required to wear current 2013 USA Swimming membership credentials on the deck area. Anyone not displaying proper credentials will be asked to leave the deck area. **Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer lane timer, or other meet position are not permitted on deck.**

Eligibility: This meet is open to invited United States Swimming Athletes of the following clubs: FAST, MACH, TIBU, Team Tollefson and RMSC. Swimmers will compete at the age attained on the first day of the meet. It may be necessary to limit entries due to the time constraints.

PVS and host clubs along with their Meet Directors are committed to the Inclusion Policy as adopted by the BOD. Athletes with a disability are welcomed and are asked to provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition

Rules: Current USA Swimming rules will govern this meet. All events are timed finals. This meet is primarily a pentathlon. In order to enter the "pentathlon competition" a swimmer must swim all four 25 yard events plus the 100 yard Individual Medley in their age group. Swimmers that are not entered in the "pentathlon competition" are limited to 3 events.

The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for the 12 &U sessions in Rule 205.3.1F.

In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations; the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. As per PVS policy; the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (i.e. cell phones, cameras, PDA's etc) are banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.

Warning: Any club that enters an unregistered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them, will be fined the sum of \$100.00, and no further entries will be accepted from the club until the said fine is paid. All swimmers, coaches and officials must be properly registered with USA Swimming for 2013.

Entry Information:

- Entry Fees: \$4.50 per individual event.
- Entry Deadline: Thursday, December 27, 2012 at 11:59 PM.
- No late entries will be accepted.
- Deck entries will be accepted provided there is an empty lane available. A heat will not be created.
- Deck Entry Fee: \$10.00 per individual event, due at time of acceptance.
- No on-deck USAS registration permitted. Swimmers must show their 2013 USAS Athlete registration card in order to deck enter.
- Meet Directors are requested to acknowledge receipt by return e-mail within 24 hours. Clubs submitting
 entries that do NOT receive an acknowledgement should contact the Meet Director by other than e-mail
 to confirm receipt.

Electronic Entry Procedures:

- Each club is requested to remit one check to cover the entry fees of the entire team. Please do not send cash. Entry Fees are due with entries.

Scoring: The championship scoring will be based on the accumulated times of the five events.

Awards: Special awards will be given for 1st to 3rd place for Overall Pentathlon in 8 year-old girl and boy and 7 & under girl and boy. Ribbons will be given for 1st to 12th place for individual events.

Spectator Admission and Heat Sheets: There will be no charge for admission. Heat sheets will be available for sale.

Swim Center Rules and Conduct

At the request of Montgomery County Recreation Department, swimmers are not to leave the pool deck without appropriate attire. Coaches will be responsible for the conduct of their athletes while in the facility and surrounding grounds. Failure to follow these rules or any inappropriate behavior will result in the athlete being barred from further competition in the meet. Parents will be responsible for the conduct of any minor children that accompany them.

- No glass containers are permitted within the facility.
- Swimmers must be in direct contact with their supervising coach before they will be allowed to enter the pool for warm-up.
- No camera cell phones are permitted in the locker rooms.

Special Note

In granting this sanction it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming, Potomac Valley Swimming, Germantown Indoor Swim Center, Rockville Montgomery Swim Club and the Montgomery County Rec Department shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.
