ELIGIBILITY	Open to all PVS teams wishing to participate. Open to USA Swimming registered swimmers.
DISABILITY SWIMMERS	PVS and host clubs along with their meet directors are committed to the Inclusion Policy as adopted by the PVS BOD. Athletes with a disability are welcomed and are asked to provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to competition.
TIMING SYSTEM	Semi-Automatic Timing Systems will be used.

RULES	Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet.
	No on-deck USA-S registration is permitted
	• In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (i.e., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.
	Deck changes are prohibited.
	 Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
	 Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
	• The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.
EVENT RULES	Individual Events: Swimmers may participate in only his or her own age group events. Swimmers may enter FOUR (4) events per DAY. To the extent there are available lanes, swimmers can request deck entry at a cost of \$15.00. *NOTE: The Meet Director reserves the right to rearrange sessions/ start times in order to allow the
POSITIVE CHECK IN	full meet to fit within the pool rental time. All Events will be pre-seeded.
WARM-UP	The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director may determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.
SUPERVISION	Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and families and for cleaning up their team areas.
	Swimmers who are not accompanied by a USA Swimming registered coach must be certified by a USA Swimming registered coach as proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. Ensuring compliance is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian.
	Only athletes, USA Swimming registered coaches, and meet officials are permitted on the pool deck. Working coaches and meet officials are required to display their 2018 USA Swimming card.
	Parents not working as a meet official, timer, or other meet position are not permitted on deck.
AWARDS	Medals will be given for places 1 st - 8 th and 1 st - 3 rd for relays.
PROGRAMS	Programs will be available for purchase for \$3.00 or via meet mobile.
CREDENTIALS	Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted on the
