<b>TIMING SYSTEM</b>	Semi-Automatic timing (buttons primary) will be used for this meet.
<b>ELIGIBILITY:</b>	Open to all USA Swimming registered athletes.  <b>Out of town teams are welcome.</b>
<b>INCLUSION POLICY FOR SWIMMERS WITH A DISABILITY:</b>	PVS and host clubs along with their Meet Directors are committed to the <a href="#">Inclusion Policy as adopted by the BOD</a> . Athletes with a disability are welcome and asked to provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete's coach is responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition.

<b>RULES:</b>	<p>Current USA Swimming rules shall govern the meet.</p> <p>All Events will be positive check in.</p> <p>No on deck USA Swimming registration is permitted.</p> <p>Deck changes are prohibited.</p> <p>Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.</p> <p>In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations; the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. As per PVS policy; the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (i.e. cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.</p> <p>Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.</p> <p>The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 &amp; U events per Rule 205.3.1F.</p>
<b>WARNING:</b>	<p>Any club that enters an unregistered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100.00 per violation. No further entries will be accepted from that Club until this fine is paid.</p>
<b>SUPERVISION:</b>	<p>Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers, and should help clean up their respective team area.</p>
<b>WARM-UP:</b>	<p>The prescribed Potomac Valley Swimming warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed.</p>
<b>OFFICIALS:</b>	<p>All certified officials who wish to volunteer should contact Craig Meledcik at craig8@comcast.net by October 15 Officials assigned to this meet should sign in at the recording table at the start of warm-ups. Officials who have not been contacted should volunteer their services to the Referee.</p>
<b>TIMERS:</b>	<p>Swimmers need to provide their own timers..</p>
<b>FEES:</b>	<p>Individual events are \$6.00. Late entries are \$ 10.00, payable at sign up.</p>

<b>ENTRIES:</b>	Email Entries (Hy-Tek), must be accompanied by a Meet Entry Report by <b>SWIMMER</b> , and a Meet Entry Report by <b>EVENT</b> from Team Manager. Event file can be found on the PVS web page.  Send entries to FAIRLANDSWIM@COMCAST.NET, in the subject heading type, "2018 Deadly Double - ****" with the club's initials substituted in place of the asterisks.
