Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted on the deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming membership with them at all times.</li> </ul>				
PROGRAMS	Meet programs will be available for purchase at each session for \$2.00.				
	A CASH ONLY snack bar will be available at all sessions of the meet in the lobby.				
MEET NOTES	• Reindeer Mini Meet T-Shirts will be available for purchase in limited quantities.				
AWARDS	• Ribbons will be awarded from 1 <sup>st</sup> -16 <sup>th</sup> place for individual events and 1 <sup>st</sup> -3 <sup>rd</sup> place for relay events <b>Special swim caps will be awarded to the winner of each individual heat.</b>				
SUPERVISION	• Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and cleaning up for their team areas.				
WARM-UP	• The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director will email attending teams the warm up assignments once all entries have been received.				
	• A swimmer may enter no more than three (3) individual events per day.				
EVENT RULES	All events are timed finals.				
	• The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.				
	• Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.				
	• Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.				
	Deck changes are prohibited.				
	<ul> <li>In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (i.e., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.</li> </ul>				
	• DECK ENTRIES will be accepted and are \$10.00 per event. Payment must be submitted with entries no later than 30 minutes prior to the first event of each session. Swimmers will be placed into open lanes. No new heats will be created.				
	No on-deck USA-S registration is permitted.				
	No Late entries are permitted for this meet.				
RULES	Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet.				

OFFICIALS	• Each participating club is requested to provide at least one table worker or official (Referee Starter, Chief Judge or Stoke & Turn Judge) per session if entering 25 or more splashes.			
	• Officials interested in volunteering should fill out this <u>form</u> or contact Carolyn Kotarski ( <u>ckotarski@gmail.com</u> ) directly.			
	• Officials assigned to this meet should sign in at the recording table 10 minutes before the start of warm-ups. Certified officials who have not previously volunteered should contact the referee upon arrival to make their services available. A comprehensive officials briefing will precede each session during warm-ups.			
TIMERS	• The host club will provide at least 1 timer per lane. Each participating club is requested to provide at least one official and 3 timers per session if entering 25 or more swimmers.			
ENTRY PROCEDURES	• Entries should be submitted using Hy-Tek Team Manager by email to the Meet Director.			
	• Include in the subject of the email, "2018 Reindeer Mini Meet -***" with the club's initials in place of the asterisks. Also include training site if your club submits multiple entry files.			
	• The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director.			
	• Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100 and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine is paid by that club.
