### PARKING INFORMATION FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND

First, the Xfinity Center is hosting State High School Basketball Championships on 3/12, 3/13, & 3/14. This means that the lots by Xfinity including Terrapin Trail Garage (TTG) will be pretty full especially in the evening hours when their games ramp up. We are wanting to push swim meet spectators to Lot 1 for most of this meet. If swim meet spectators want to steer clear of heavy campus traffic they should enter campus via 193 and Stadium Dr. Here is the per day parking plan.

Parking available after 4pm in Lot 1 or TTG (very limited due to State High School).

## Friday 3/13

  - There are 500 spaces available.
  - We asked folks who have permits and are here for the morning session, to give them up for folks in the midday session to avoid some of the issues of not enough spaces. UMD is prepared to have a staff member out at Lot 1 this year, to encourage that practice.
- There are also metered spots available in Stadium Drive Garage and Regents Drive Garage on campus. As UMD is going into Spring Break, several of these will likely be available, but the cost is \$3 per hour. https://maps.umd.edu/map/

## Saturday 3/14


• Parking available in Lot 1 or TTG (very limited due to State High School). Please leave early to allow extra time for drop off and parking.

Attached is an parking map of Lot 1 and Lot Z. These are the lots that are free after 4pm and on weekends. You can see that there is also a JJ3 lot which does allow for parking so make sure to let attendees know these spaces are off limits. Parking Services also wanted to make mention that any signage takes precedent over normal lot restrictions so please just have attendees be mindful of any additional signs that are posted.

Finally, one thing that we have noticed more frequently is spectators parking in the two lots (SS1 & SS2) on either side of the ERC. These lots are for RecWell staff only and even on weekends are used by our staff. Can we please put out information saying that these are off limits and we will be increasing ticket enforcement and potential towing if parked in these two lots



### **Farm Drive Closure**

If you haven't been to campus recently there has been a change to Farm Drive. It no longer is a through road from Regents Dr. to Valley Dr. Attached is a map and will see the red line where Farm Dr. used to be but is now currently closed as a construction site. The university has created a new road next to the site which connects Valley Dr. back to Stadium Dr. (which is highlighted in Yellow). We are strongly suggesting anyone dropping off, picking up, and your shuttles to enter campus at the 193 and Stadium Dr entrance. Then proceed to Valley Dr. and take that back around to Stadium Dr. to exit campus.
