TIMING SYSTEM Automatic timing (touchpads primary) will be used for this meet. **RULES** Current USA Swimming rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), shall govern this meet. No on-deck USA-S registration is permitted. In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods. Deck changes are prohibited. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Dive-over starts will not be used at this meet. The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F. No deck entries accepted. **EVENT RULES** All events are timed finals. All events are open age group, mixed gender. COVID-19 An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. CONSIDERATIONS COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. PROTOCOLS All attendees (athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers, spectators) must wear a mask to enter the Complex and throughout the Complex, with the exception of athletes when competing or warming up/cooling down. All attendees will be required to complete a health attestation. Members of the St. James may complete this via The St. James app. Non-members will be required to fill out a form. Prior to Complex entry, all attendees will receive a touch-less temperature screening. Per CDC guidelines, individuals with a body temperature greater than 100.4 degrees will not be permitted entry into the Complex. We request that all attendees notify the meet director as soon as possible if they have tested positive for COVID-19, shown symptoms or have been in contact with anyone exposed to COVID-19 after attending the meet. Spectators, outside of family members of competing athletes, are not permitted. POSITIVE CHECK IN No Positive Check in at this meet. All events will be pre-seeded WARM-UP The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. Warm up will be an open warm up. SUPERVISION Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and cleaning up for their team areas SEEDING All events will be pre-seeded. PROGRAMS Meet programs will not be available. CREDENTIALS Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted on the deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming membership with them at all times. SPECTATOR ENTRY There will be no spectator entry fee FEE **OFFICIALS** All officials will be provided by the host club. A comprehensive official's briefing will be conducted the night prior to the meet via Zoom. TIMERS Swimmers must provide their own timer. **ENTRY** Entries will be managed by the Meet Director, Evan Stiles estile@arlingtonnva.us. **PROCEDURES** Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any

	way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100 by PVS and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine is paid.
