## COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

- All attendees (athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers, spectators) must wear a mask to enter the facility and throughout the facility, with the exception of athletes when competing or warming up/cooling down.
- Athletes must arrive and depart in their suits. Locker room use is minimized to emergency use only.
- Spectators will not be permitted into the facility. The meet will be live streamed on YouTube. The link will be shared with participating families. Before signing up your young swimmer, please consider that they can manage themselves for the duration of the meet with just their swim coach overseeing them, including being able to visit the bathroom independently.
- Each session will be limited to 96 swimmers.
- One timer will be assigned to each lane as a backup timer. Markings on the ground will separate the swimmers from the timers while staging and entering/exiting the pool.
- Entry for all participants, volunteers and coaches will be through the main pool entrance, exit will be through the Bistro doors or out any pool door exit.
- Before entering the facility participants, coaches and volunteers are required to be able to answer the following questions and will only be permitted entrance if answering with 'no':
  - Do you feel any of the symptoms that fall under the Covid-19 (fever over 100.4, cough, shortness of breath, etc.)?
  - Has anyone in your family been sick or diagnosed with Covid-19?
  - Has someone you've been in contact with been diagnosed with Covid-19 or been in contact with someone who has?

	<ul> <li>Additional sanitation will take place as well as sanitation stations will be available in various locations throughout the facility.</li> </ul>
	• HEPA Filtration system will be placed on the pool deck and in high traffic rooms for additional air purification.
	UV Light is used along with chlorine to disinfect the water constantly.
RULES	• Current USA Swimming rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), shall govern this meet.
	No on-deck USA-S registration is permitted.
	• In compliance with <i>USA Swimming Rules and Regulations</i> , the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.
	Deck changes are prohibited.
	• Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
	<ul> <li>Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.</li> </ul>
	Dive-over starts will be used at this meet.
	• The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.
	No deck entries will be accepted.
<b>EVENT RULES</b>	All events are timed finals.
	• Swimmers may compete is up to seven events throughout the weekend and no more than four events Saturday and three events Sunday.
	• Swimmers must swim in their designated age group based on their age on 10/10/2020.
	• The meet director reserves the right to change the format of the meet to best accommodate the space and time for each session.
POSITIVE CHECK IN	• All events will be pre-seeded on Friday, October 9. All changes must be submitted no later than 12pm on Friday, October 9.
WARM-UP	The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director may determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.
	No more than 6 swimmers per lane (48 total) will be permitted and warm up protocol will be provided prior to the meet for coaches.
SUPERVISION	• Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and cleaning up for their team areas.
	<ul> <li>Meet Marshals will be used to patrol the facility as well as help with crowd control and COVID regulation compliance.</li> </ul>
SEEDING	All events will be swum fast to slow.

	The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director.
