TIMING SYSTEM	Semi-Automatic timing (buttons primary) will be used for this meet. Automatic timing
RULES	 (touchpads primary) will be used for the distance session. Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet.
NOLES	 All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
	No on-deck USA Swimming registration is permitted.
	• In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.
	Deck changes are prohibited.
	• Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
	 Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
	Dive-over starts will be used for the distance session only.
	• The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.
EVENT RULES	All events are timed finals.
	• Swimmers may enter no more than three (3) individual and one (1) relay events per day. No more than six (6) individual and one (1) relay event for the meet.
	The distance events will be swum mixed gender.
	Swimmers must provide their own timer and counter (if desired) for the distance events.
	• Conforming seed times for the distance events are short course yards (SCY). LCM and NTs will be accepted.
	Swimmers may only enter one (1) event for the distance session.
	• 12 & Under athletes may only enter one (1) session per day.
	Deck entries will be accepted into empty lanes only. No new heats will be created.
	Evidence of current USA Swimming registration required for deck entries.
POSITIVE CHECK IN	All Relays will need to be checked in by the end of warm up for each session.
	• All events in the distance session will require positive check by 2:20 pm. Swimmers who do not
MADMA LID	check in will not be seeded into the event.
WARM-UP	 The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director will assign times and lane assignments for the warm up.
	• Continuous warm up/ warm down lanes will be available. Coaches must monitor their swimmers while in these lanes.
SUPERVISION	• Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and cleaning up for their team areas.
SEEDING	 All individual events will be pre-seeded. Relays will be seeded after check in. The distance events will be seeded fast to slow. Nonconforming times will be seeded after SCY times.
