

	The pool at PWCS Aquatics Center is 40m x 25yd with a moveable bulkhead. Competition will be held in 8 lanes, 25 yards, running from wall to wall.		
	 Water depth ranges from 12.5' – 7' at the starting and turning ends. 		
	• 15 lanes are available for warm-ups. Continuous warm-up/cool-down will be available.		
	The meet hosts will ensure the required course dimensions.		
ENTRY DEADLINE	April 2, 2024 at 9:00 p.m.		
	IMPORTANT: The above date is the deadline for clubs to submit their entries to the Meet Director. Therefore, clubs usually set an earlier deadline to receive entries from their swimmers. Check with your club for this information.

	Warm-up at 10:00 a.m. Events at 10:45 a.m.		
	 Meet Director reserves the right to adjust times/sessions after entries are received. 		
ELIGIBILITY	Open to all invited, registered Potomac Valley Swimmers and invited teams.		
	 No swimmer will be permitted to compete in the meet unless the swimmer is registered as an athlete member of USA Swimming as provided in USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 302. 		
	Swimmers shall compete at the age attained on the first day of the meet.		
	It may be necessary to limit entries due to time constraints.		
DISABILITY SWIMMERS	 PVS and host clubs along with their meet directors are committed to the <u>Inclusion Policy</u> as adopted by the PVS BOD. Athletes with a disability are welcomed and are asked to provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to competition. 		
TIMING SYSTEM	Semi-automatic timing (buttons primary) will be used.		
SPECTATOR ADMISSION	No charge for spectator admission. Upstairs bleacher area is available for spectator seating.		
RULES	Current USA Swimming rules including the <u>Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP")</u> shall govern this meet.		
	 No on-deck USA Swimming registration is permitted. In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording 		
	• In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording		

	devices, including a cell phone is banned in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.
	Deck changes are prohibited.
	 Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
	 Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
	Dive-over starts will not be used.
	• The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.
EVENT RULES	All events are timed finals.
DOCUMENTS OF THE OWNER.	A swimmer may enter no more than four (4) events.
POSITIVE CHECK IN WARM-UP	All events will be pre-seeded.
WARIVI-UP	• The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director will determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.
	The Meet Director reserves the right to adjust times / sessions after the entries are received.
SUPERVISION	Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and for cleaning up their team areas.
AWARDS	There are no awards at this meet.
PROGRAMS	Programs will be posted on the Marlins website and emailed to participating teams.
CREDENTIALS	Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted on the deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming membership with them.
OFFICIALS	• Each participating club is requested to provide at least one table worker or official (Referee Starter, Chief Judge or Stroke & Turn Judge) per session if entering 25 or more splashes.

	 Officials volunteering for this meet should sign in at the recording table prior to the start of warm-ups. Certified officials who have not previously volunteered should contact the referee upon arrival to make their services available. A comprehensive officials' briefing will precede each session during warm-ups. Application to Officiate
TIMERS	Participating clubs are requested to provide timers in proportion to their entries. One timer is requested for each 25 entries.

ENTRY PROCEDURES	Entries should be submitted by email to the Meet Director.		
	Include in the subject of the email, "2024 Earth Day Rumble" - ****" with the club's initials in place of the asterisks. If your club submits multiple entry files include training site in the subject of the email.		
	Include in entry email: entry file, report of entries by name.		
	In the body of your email provide entry numbers (girls, boys, totals), contact information (email, phone, officials contact).		
	 Entries directly from individual team members will not be accepted. Entries by phone or fax will not be accepted. The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director. Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100 by PVS and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine is paid.

	Payment for entries from unattached swimmers not affiliated with a team must be received prior to the meet. Payment may be made by cash or check.		
	Entry fees are due with meet entry. Unpaid fees will be reported to the PVS Administrative Office at the conclusion of the meet.
