ELIGIBILITY	 Open to all registered and invited Occoquan Swimming members and other teams. No swimmer will be permitted to compete in the meet unless the swimmer is registered as an athlete member of USA Swimming as provided in USA Swimming Rules and Regulations Article 302.

The athlete (or athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session Referee in writing of any desired accommodation/modifications prior to competition.
TIMING SYSTEM	Automatic Timing (touchpads primary) will be used.
RULES	Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet.
	All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
	No on-deck USA Swimming registration is permitted.
	 In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.
	Deck changes are prohibited.
	 Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
	 Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
	Dive-over starts may be used.
	• The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.
EVENT RULES	All events will be swum as timed finals and seeded fastest to slowest heats
	Events in session 1 will be swum at Burke in 25 yard course.
	• Events in sessions 2-5 will be swum at Freedom Center in a 50 meter course.
	Swimmers in session 1 must provide their own timer for all events.
	All swimmers must provide their own timer and counter (if desired) for the 800m free
	All swimmers must provide their own timer for the 10 & Under 200m free on Friday.
	All swimmers must provide their own timer for the 12 & under 200 IM on Sunday.
	All swimmers must provide their own timer for the 400m IM and 400m free
	• The 400 free and 400 IM may be limited to 8 total heats for each age group (top 72 in each) based on 500 yard free and 400-yard IM entry times. If time permits additional heats may be added.
	The 800 free may be limited to 6 total heats with a minimum of 30 female athletes and 30 male athletes based on 1000-yard entry times.
	If a swimmer is removed from a distance event, they will be provided the opportunity to enter

	an alternate event if desired.
	Swimmers 13 & over may enter and compete in up to three (3) events each day, with a
	maximum of seven (7) events for the meet.
	Swimmers 12 & under may enter and compete in up to four (4) events each day, with a
	maximum of nine (9) events for the meet.
	Swimmers aged 12 & under may only enter one (1) session per day.
	Swimmers must swim in their designated age group based on their age on May 2, 2025.
	 Events will be seeded using SCY times.
	NT entries will not be accepted. Swimmers should have swum the event they plan to swim in a
	short course meet before swimming in this meet.
	Note: entries in the 400 free will appear as 500 free in the event file and entries in the 800 free
	will appear as 1000 free in the event file.
	Deck entries will be accepted in empty lanes only. No new heats will be created. Deck entries
	are \$20 per entry.

WARM-UP	The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet
	Director may determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments and will
	share with the attending teams no later than 3 days prior to the meet.
	If timelines permit, lane 1 will be reserved for warm up and cool down throughout the meet.

	Saturday & Sunday events 400m and longer will be seeded following the check in deadline
	which is 30 minutes prior to the start of the session.
	The 13 & over 400 free and 400 IM if there are more than six heats in each gender these events
	may be swum as the four fastest heats of women (fast-to-slow) will be followed by the four fastest
	heats of men (fast to slow). The remaining heats will be swum fast-to-slow, alternating women and
	men. If there are five or fewer heats, the events will be swum all women (fast to slow) then all men
	(fast-to-slow).
	The meet director may determine if combining or splitting events or sessions is needed to provide additional competitive apportunities and time between events.

SCORING	No scoring will be used for this meet.							
AWARDS	No individual event awards will be provided							
PROGRAMS	Programs will not be sold, however the meet will be available on Meet Mobile and a meet program will be posted on the OCCS website after the scratch deadlines.							
CREDENTIALS	Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position will have very limited access to the facility. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted in certain areas on the deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming membership with them at all times.							
OFFICIALS	 Each participating club is requested to provide at least one table worker or official (Referee Starter, Chief Judge or Stroke & Turn Judge) per session if entering 25 or more splashes. Officials interested in volunteering should complete the Officials Signup or contact John Avelis. 							
	 Officials volunteering for this meet should sign in at the recording table prior to the start of warm-ups. Certified officials who have not previously volunteered should contact the referee upon arrival to make their services available. A comprehensive officials' briefing will precede each session during warm-ups 							
TIMERS &	Two timers per lane will be asked to volunteer.							
VOLUNTEERS	• Timers and volunteers will be required to sign up prior to the meet and will be required to adhere to all facility and USA Swimming rules and regulations including the MAAPP policies.							
	Volunteer details will be provided prior to the meet.							
	Timers and Marshals brief will take place at the meet about 30 minutes prior to the start of each session.							
	• Each participating club will be asked to provide timers for the competition and a sign up process will be sent out to participating clubs at least four days prior to the meet.							
ENTRY	Entries must be submitted by email to the Meet Director, meets@swimoccs.org.							
PROCEDURES	• Include in the subject of the email, "Speedo Spring Splash - ****" with the club's initials in place of the asterisks. If your club submits multiple entry files include training site in the subject of the email.							
	Include in entry email: entry file, report of entries by name, report of entries by event.							
	• In the body of your email provide contact information (email, phone, officials contact).							
	Entries directly from individual team members will not be accepted.							
	Entries by phone or fax will not be accepted.							
	The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director.							
	• Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100 by PVS and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine is paid.
