ELIGIBILITY	Please read Meet Announcement carefully for new information.
	• Open to athletes from invited USA Swimming clubs and registered athletes.
	• Athletes shall compete at the age attained on the first day of the meet.
	• No swimmer will be permitted to compete in the meet unless the swimmer is registered as an athlete member of USA Swimming as provided in USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 302.
SWIMMERS WITH A DISABILITY	<ul> <li>PVS and host clubs along with their Meet Directors are committed to the <u>Inclusion Policy</u> as adopted by the PVS BOD. Athletes with a disability are welcomed and are asked to provide advance written notice of desired accommodations/modifications to the Meet Director and Meet Referee. The athlete (or athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session Referee in writing of any desired accommodation/modifications prior to competition.</li> </ul>
TIMING SYSTEM	Automatic timing (touchpads primary) will be used.
RULES	Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet.
	• All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming <u>Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy</u> ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
	<ul> <li>No on-deck USA Swimming registration is permitted.</li> </ul>
	• In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.
	Deck changes are prohibited.
	• Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
	• Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
	• Dive-over starts may be used.
	• The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & Under events per Rule 205.3.1F.
EVENT RULES	<ul> <li>All events are timed finals.</li> <li>This meet has no qualifying times. Short course times are conforming.</li> <li>Athletes shall compete at the age attained on the first day of the meet; and may only compete in his or her own age division.</li> <li>A contestant may enter no more than four (4) individual events per day.</li> <li>Deck entries will be accepted however no new heats will be created. The deck entry fee is \$15.00 per individual event plus athlete surcharge if not already in meet. For swimmers not already in the meet, proof of USA Swimming Registration will be required to be entered in meet.</li> </ul>
POSITIVE CHECK-IN	<ul> <li>Events may require positive check-in. If so, check-in closing times will be 30 minutes before the start of the session for the first 3 strokes and the remaining events will close 90 minutes after the start of the first event of the session.</li> <li>Session 1 events 1-12 close at 7:30 AM and 13-20 at 9:30 AM</li> <li>Session 2 events 21-28 close at 1:30 PM and 29-38 at 3:30 PM</li> <li>Session 3 events 39-50 close at 7:30 AM and 51-58 at 9:30 AM</li> </ul>

WARM-UP	• The prescribed Potomac Valley Swimming warm-up procedures and safety policies for Open warm-ups will be followed.
	<ul> <li>The Meet Director reserves the right to modify the warm-up times and structure, if necessary.</li> </ul>
SUPERVISION	<ul> <li>Swimmers must be in direct contact with their supervising coach before they will be allowed to</li> </ul>
	enter the pool for warm-up.
	<ul> <li>Swimmers are required to take a shower before entering pool for warm up.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and families and for cleaning up their team areas.</li> </ul>
	• Due to limited deck space, there will be NO chairs on deck except for coaches.
SEEDING	• Short course times are conforming times for this meet. Non-conforming times will be seeded after conforming times.
SCORING	This meet will not be scored.
AWARDS	None.
PROGRAMS	<ul> <li>Programs will be available on Meet Mobile.</li> </ul>
	Printed programs will be available for coaches and officials.
CREDENTIALS	Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials are permitted on the pool deck.
	• Working Coaches & deck officials are required to display or produce their current USA Swimming credentials on the USA Swimming App.
	• Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer lane timer, or other meet position are not permitted on deck. Please cooperate with the meet marshals.
SPECTATOR ENTRY FEE	There is no admission charge.
	• All swimmers and spectators should enter the facility through the pool lobby. Coaches and Officials ONLY may use the side entrance to the pool deck.
	• The hospitality table, located on the pool deck will be available to all coaches, officials and other meet volunteers.
	<ul> <li>Spectator capacity is limited to 250 people in the gallery.</li> <li>No chairs may be set up in the lobby or gallery areas.</li> </ul>
MEDICAL ASSISTANCE	• Medical assistance will be provided by the facility staff. If you require medical assistance, please notify a facility lifeguard or a member of the meet staff.
OFFICIALS	• Each participating club is requested to provide at least one table worker or official (Referee Starter, Chief Judge or Stroke & Turn Judge) per session if entering 25 or more splashes.
	• Officials interested in volunteering may sign up on the officials sign up link or contact Carla Austin, caustin.enllc@gmail.com.
	<ul> <li>Officials volunteering for this meet should sign in at the recording table prior to the start of warm-ups. Certified officials who have not previously volunteered should contact the referee upon arrival to make their services available. A comprehensive official briefing will precede each session during warm-ups.</li> </ul>
TIMERS	• Participating clubs are requested to provide timers in proportion to their entries. One timer is requested for each 25 splashes.
	• Friday night is a Distance Session; therefore, swimmers must provide their own timer and counter, if desired. Volunteers are still needed as Marshals and Head Timers. You will be able to leave your position to time your child, however, we do ask you to stay until the end of the session.

	<ul> <li>Include in the subject of the email, "2025 Early Bird LC - ****" with the club's initials in place of the asterisks. If your club submits multiple entry files, include the training site in the subject of the email.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Include in the entry email: entry file and report of entries by name.</li> </ul>	
	• In the body of your email provide entry numbers (girls, boys, totals), contact information (email, phone, officials contact).	
	Entries directly from individual team members will not be accepted.	
	Entries by phone or fax will not be accepted.	
	• The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director.	
	<ul> <li>Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100 by PVS and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine is paid.</li> </ul>
