	No on-deck USA Swimming registration is permitted.
	In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual
	recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms,
	or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell
	phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet,
	including warm up, competition and cool down periods.
	Deck changes are prohibited.
	Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member
	coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from
	within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a
	member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian
	to ensure compliance with this requirement.
	Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools,
	athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes,
	coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
	Dive-over starts may be used.
	The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats,
	swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that

	Seed times are short course yards.
	Athletes may enter a total of four (4) events per day not including a relay.
	The 500 freestyle events will be swum mixed gender.
	All relays are mixed gender.
	Swimmers must provide their own timer and counter (if desired) for the 500 Freestyle.
	Deck entries will be accepted in empty lanes only. No new heats will be created.
	The Meet Director reserves the right to alter the format of the meet after entries are
	received to best accommodate timelines and space availability.
POSITIVE CHECK IN	All Events will be pre-seeded
WARM-UP	The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet
-	Director will determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.
SUPERVISION	Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and for cleaning up their team
	areas.

AWARDS	• 12 and under swimmers will receive ribbons for 1 st – 5 th place.		
PROGRAMS	 Meet programs will be available on the ASTS website the evening before the meet at http://www.accokeekstroketechnique.com and on Meet Mobile. 		
CREDENTIALS	 Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted on the deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming membership with them. 		
SPECTATOR ENTRY FEE	 Spectator seating will be made available on a first come first serve basis. Spectator Entry fees are as follows: All session pass: \$15.00. Spectators will receive a wristband that will need to worn in order to enter. There are no individual sessions passes Anyone under the age of 12 not swimming is free of charge 		
OFFICIALS	 Each participating club is requested to provide at least one table worker or official (Referee Starter, Chief Judge or Stroke & Turn Judge) per session if entering 25 or more splashes. Officials interested in volunteering should contact the Meet Official, Heather Purk, Hkpurk@gmail.com, Officials volunteering for this meet should sign in at the recording table prior to the start of warm-ups. Certified officials who have not previously volunteered should contact the referee upon arrival to make their services available. A comprehensive officials' briefing will precede each session during warm-ups. 		
TIMERS	 Participating clubs are requested to provide timers in proportion to their entries. One timer is requested for each 25 entries. A Timer Sign-up link will be sent to the coaches. 		
ENTRY PROCEDURES	Entries should be submitted by email to the Meet Director.		
	• Include in the subject of the email, "ASTS Invitational- ****" with the club's initials in place		

- Include in the subject of the email, "ASTS Invitational- ****" with the club's initials in place of the asterisks. If your club submits multiple entry files include training site in the subject of the email.
- Include in entry email: entry file, report of entries by name, report of entries by event.
- In the body of your email provide entry numbers (girls, boys, totals), contact information (email, phone, officials contact).
- Entries directly from individual team members will not be accepted.
- Entries by phone or fax will not be accepted.
- The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director.
- Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100 by PVS and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine is paid.
