Proposed language:

- The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.
- Recommending approval of Moon Aquatic Club- (*Discussion needed & Vote Required.*)

Report Items:

Per the direction of the BOD in the December 2011 meeting, all teams that had swimmers swim in a meet when they were not registered have been reported to John Ertter to be fined. As of January 2011, 8 fines for \$100.00 each have been issued. In accordance with the policy passed in December 2011, 50% of fines collected will be sent to the USA Swimming Foundation.

The December 2011, Executive Session matter regarding a Board of Review case has been resolved.

The Administrative Division is currently red-lining the current version of PVS P&P to resolve matters with the manual that are out of date or incorrect to our current "practices". A reminder to all BOD members to please review areas that is under your division and sends corrections to me.

The General Chair & I have been contacting other large LSC's in the country in an effort to understand how they organize their permanent and part time office staff. Areas we are reviewing are number of full vs. part time employees, hours per week for certain jobs, job descriptions, etc. The Eastern Zone will be hosting a GC conference call next week and we have added this topic to the round table discussion in the call.

As of January 8th, 2012, the PVS registrar is reporting 9453 athletes registered to 37 teams in PVS. Of the 37 active teams in PVS, 15 clubs have 1-100 athletes, 5 clubs have 100-200 athletes registered, and 3 clubs have 200-300 athletes registered. 4 clubs have 300-400 athletes, 2 have 400-500 athletes, 1 has 500-600 athletes, 1 has 600-700 athletes and 2 have 1500+. 121 swimmers are registered as Unattached in the LSC. The national average size of a club is 75-100 swimmers.

Our largest population of swimmers within the LSC continues to be our 8 & Under swimmers. (Report attached.)

We have 416 officials certified & registered for 2012. We currently show 52 previously registered OFFICIALS are now non-active.
