- Plans continue to be made for the 2011 Going for the Gold Diversity Day with special guest Gold Medal Olympian Anthony Ervin on **April 14th**, **2012**. The location has been set for Wilson Aquatic Center. We will have applications for 50 PVS Athletes to attend the advanced swim clinic and 50 learn to swim program participants who apply on a first come first serve bases.
