


# PVS Membership Study: Status Update




## Geographic Locations – January 2008 BOD Meeting



### PVS Membership Distribution (Geocoding)





#### Maryland

- Membership is concentrated in Montgomery County, which has about 82% of Maryland athletes (29% overall)
- Maryland has 2,896 athletes (35% overall)

#### District of Columbia (2007)

DC has 288 athletes (3.5% overall)

#### **Notes**

- Others: Mailing addresses outside of DC, MD and VA account for 93 athletes (just over 1% overall)
- Not Available: Not sent for geocoding or experienced error during geocoding




# Geographic Locations – January 2008 BOD Meeting



## PVS Membership Distribution (Geocoding)





#### Virginia

- Like Maryland, the bulk of PVS members is concentrated in one county (Fairfax), which accounts for 66% of Virginia members (40% overall)
- Virginia has 4,940 athletes (60% overall)
- Item of note: With the creation of Patriot Swim Club (PATS) about 150 swimmers will move to VA LSC.
  - 122 from Prince William County
  - 15 from Fairfax County
  - 9 unknown county
  - 3 from Fauquier County
  - 2 from Loudoun County
  - 2 from Manassas City


## Geographic Locations – Census Tract Density Maps





# Age Group Distribution (Percent of Total)






### **Overall Attrition Rate**



- What is the attrition rate for members?
  - "Attrition": percent of swimmers that do not register with PVS in the following year.
  - Four year average is 34.66%.
- This rate does not include swimmer migration from one team to another team.
- 2007 attrition rate includes departure of PATS




## Attrition – Age Distribution







## Attrition Rate By Age Group







## Attrition Rate By Gender










2007 Attrition Rate based on 2008 Registrations as of 1/23/2008




## Average Attrition Rate by Club (2004 thru 2006)

Only PVS clubs whose membership averaged over 100 during the period.






## **Incoming Swimmers**



- There are two categories of swimmers who are "new" to PVS in a season:
  - "New" swimmers are those who have not been registered with USA Swimming in the preceding 12 years or are new to swimming.
  - "Renew" are swimmers who were registered with USA Swimming at some point in the preceding 12 years.



# **Incoming Swimmers**





## **Key Points**

- For the most part PVS profile mirrors USA Swimming
- About 1/3 of our swimmers do not re-register in the following year.
  - Age 14 seems a critical age for re-registration.
  - There appears to be an age difference in the attrition rates for Females and Males.
  - Clubs could share best practices on retaining swimmers.
- Incoming swimmers
  - About 20% of swimmers joining a PVS club are returning swimmers who had left PVS for a while.



## **Next Steps**


- Prepare HOD report

  - Geographic distribution of members
  - Meet participation




#### **Montogomery County**






### **Princes Georges County**












