Park Authority Schedules Meeting on Fee Changes

The Fairfax County Park Authority will provide an opportunity for citizens to comment on its proposed fee changes for 2007 at a Public Information and Comment Meeting on **Wednesday, January 31, 2007**. The meeting will be held at 7 p.m. in Room 106 on the first floor in the **Herrity Building** located at 12055 Government Center Parkway in Fairfax, VA.

Public comment is invited. Citizens may attend the public comment meeting or contact the Park Authority via **email** or send their comments to: Attention Public Information Office/Fee Comments, Fairfax County Park Authority, 12055 Government Center Parkway, Suite 927, Fairfax, VA 22035-1118. Written comments will be accepted through February 6, 2007.

This meeting provides information and a chance to comment on proposed changes to the Park Authority fee structure that may raise, reduce, create or eliminate fees. Hardcopies of the fee proposal will be available in the Herrity Building and at staffed park facilities, including all RECenters, golf courses, nature centers and historic sites beginning January 8, 2007.

Citizens who wish to speak at the meeting may pre-register by calling the Public Information Office at 703-324-8662. Speakers need not register in advance. If you require a sign language interpreter or other special accommodations, please call 703-324-8563 or 703-324-3988 TTY at least ten days prior to the meeting.

The Herrity Building may be reached by taking beltway exit 49 (I-66 west) to Route 50 west to West Ox Road south. Turn left onto Monument Drive. Follow Monument approximately half a mile to Government Center Parkway. Take the first right to the parking garage at the Herrity Building.

3. Lee District RECenter Playroom fees. Staff recommends an increase in the hourly and drop-in fees (last adjusted in 2002) to stay current with the market.

4. Indoor Swimming Pool Base Rates (Per Hour). Staff recommends the following adjustment in base natatorium rental fees last changed in 2004.

Currently, long-term contract rates are discounted off the base fee according to the amount of pool space rented. Staff proposes eliminating the four-tiered model, replacing it with a single 25% discount for organizations/groups that rent at least 3,000 lane hours per season and are comprised of 90% Fairfax County residents at the facility where space is being rented.
