Public comment is invited. Written comments will be accepted through February 6, 2007.

This meeting provides information and a chance to comment on proposed changes to the Park Authority fee structure that may raise, reduce, create or eliminate fees. Hardcopies of the fee proposal will be available in the Herrity Building and at staffed park facilities, including all RECenters, golf courses, nature centers and historic sites beginning January 8, 2007.

4. <u>Indoor Swimming Pool Base Rates (Per Hour)</u>. Staff recommends the following adjustment in base natatorium rental fees last changed in 2004.

Currently, long-term contract rates are discounted off the base fee according to the amount of pool space rented. Staff proposes eliminating the four-tiered model, replacing it with a single 25% discount for organizations/groups that rent at least 3,000 lane hours per season and are comprised of 90% Fairfax County residents at the facility where space is being rented.
