Athlete Of The Year

Dan Jacobs and I are working on a new points system for selecting our Age Group athletes of the year...Several LSC have sent me their methods of selecting their swimmers of the year and all of them use a points based system. We presented our new selection process at the May Competition Committee meeting in all in attendance voted in favor of adopting this new system.

IMX Award:

We are currently discussing my proposal for an IMX award which will go to the one male and female in any "single age group" who achieves the highest IMX score in the LSC. Details and season time frames are being worked out. The award will be given out annually for achievements in the SCY season & LCM season.

Adaptive Athlete of the Year Award:

I have also proposed that we award an "Adaptive Swimmer of the Year Award". This proposal went over well with the BOD and Don Reidlinger has developed a points system to select this well deserving Athlete. The points system will be presented to the Competition Committee in May for their approval then brought before the BOD for acceptance.
