

2001 USA SWIMMING DISABILITY CHAMPIONSHIPS

Dates: June 22-24, 2001 (classification on June 20-21)

Location: Phoenix Swim Club, Phoenix, Arizona

Eligible Swimmers:

- Swimmers who are deaf
- Swimmers who are blind/visually impaired
- Swimmers with cognitive disabilities such as mental retardation, severe learning disabilities, and autism
- Swimmers with physical disabilities such as amputations, cerebral palsy, dwarfism, spina bifida/spinal cord injury, and other mobility impairments

Events: 50-100-200-400-800-1500 freestyle
50-100-200 backstroke
50-100-200 breaststroke
50-100-200 butterfly
150-200-400 individual medley
4x50-4x100-4x200 freestyle relay
4x50-4x100 medley relay

Distances offered depend upon the swimmer's classification.
