USA Swimming Grand Prix Series

Grand prix meets still filling up at an alarming pace...many G.P. meets closed entries only hours after opening up. This is most likely due to the Olympic year boom. USA swimming has said they would like to run an east coast and a west coast Grand Prix Series in the new quad (2013-2016). This will help with overcrowded meets and with travel expenses as well as missed school time for the HS aged athlete.

So far one club from Canada has been invited to participate in the 2012 LC Sr. Champs...they expect to have about 35 swimmers and 250 entries...no paperwork is required for them to swim in the US. Additionally 3 out of LSC teams have asked to attend the LC Sr. Champs meet and have been granted permission to enter. At this point I feel the out of LSC entries are close to the 10% max and most likely no further out of LSC teams will be accepted.

Currently PVS has 39 swimmers who have qualified for the 2012 US Olympic Trials.
