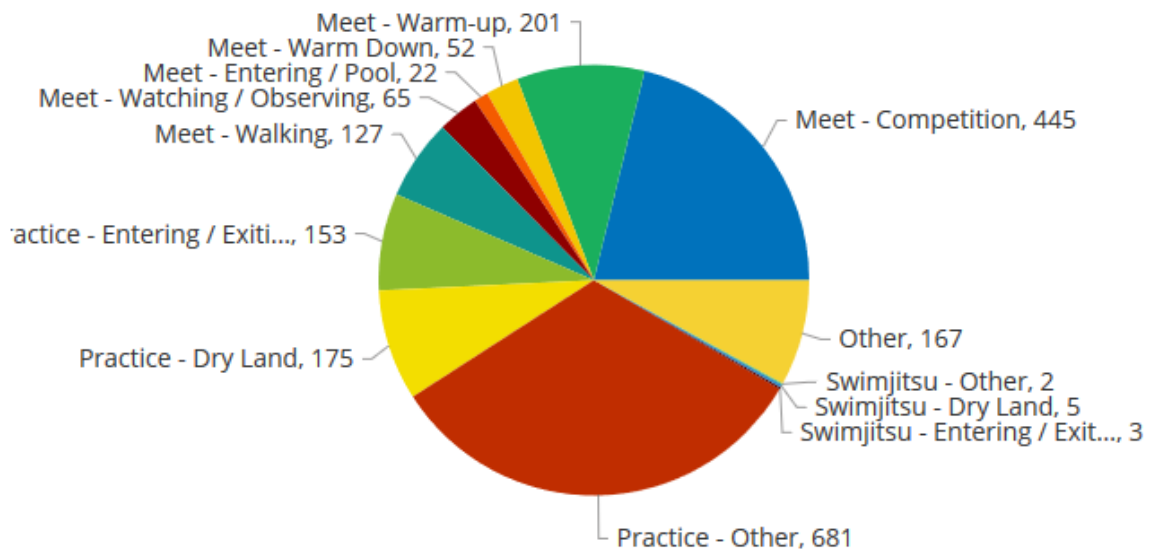

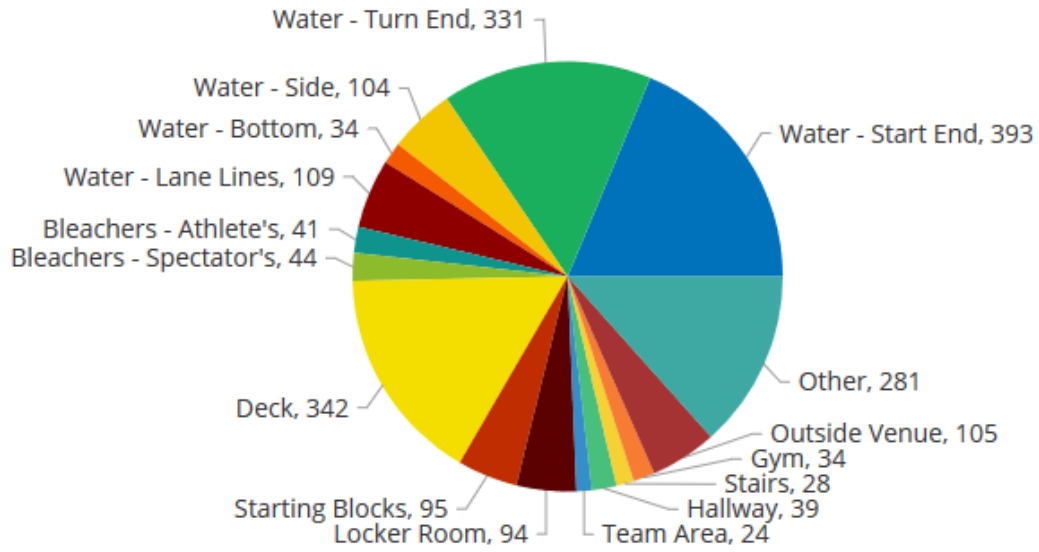
Activity at Time of Injury

WHERE ACCIDENTS HAPPEN

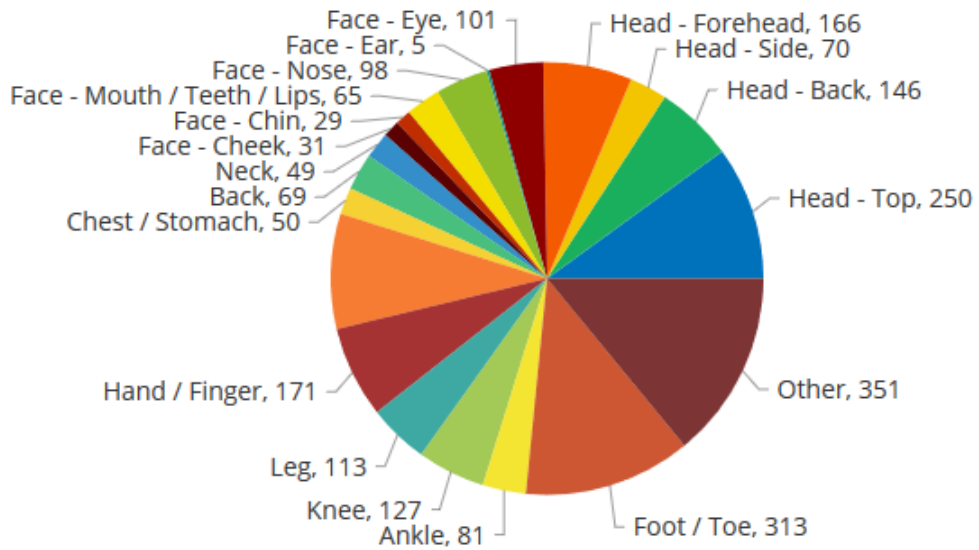
Where Accident Occurred

AFFECTED BODY PART

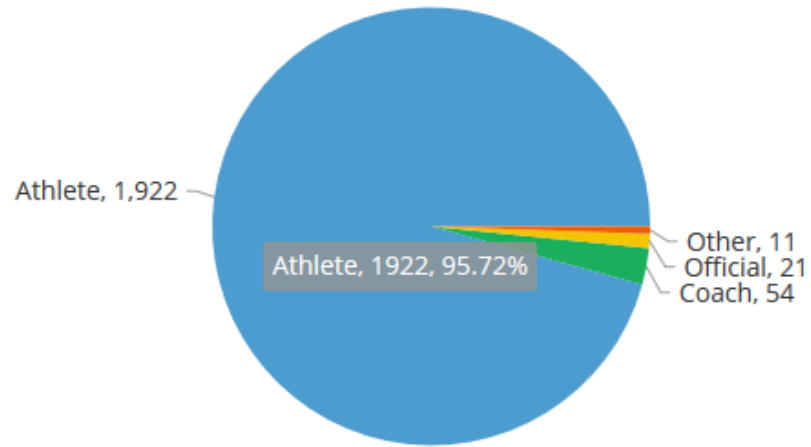
Body Part Injured

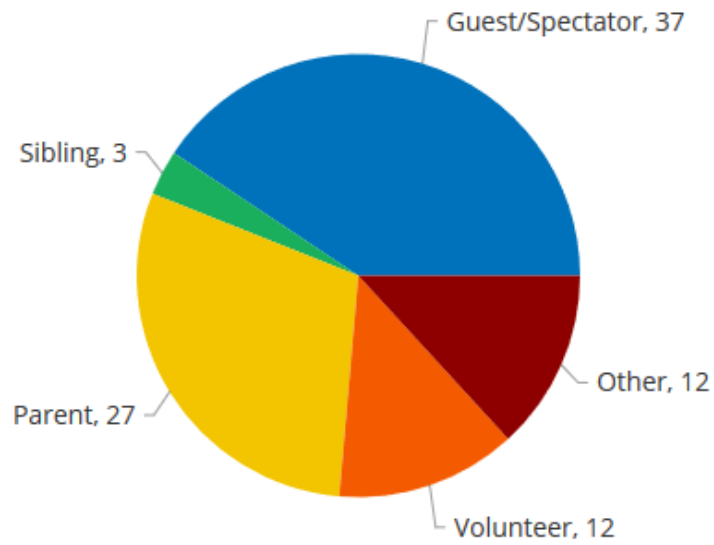
MEMBER/NON-MEMBER TYPE
