PVS Age Group Report for 2006-2007

PVS Age Group Coach of the Year: Information on submitting a nomination for PVS Age Group Coach of the Year had been posted on the PVS website (http://www.pvswim.org/07agegrpcoach_instr.htm).

Nominations are due by May 31, 2007. The person selected will have his/her expenses paid to the ASCA convention in September in order to receive the award in person.

Selection Criteria for PVS Athlete of the Year: No change to selection process for 2007.

Entry Times and Criteria for PVS Distance Meets / Events: Though a bit more labor intensive for meet managers, the new entry criteria worked well.

PVS 2006 Eastern Zone LC Team: 116 swimmers attended—twice as many as in 2005—resulting in the ability to enter two relays in most events. PVS placed 5th overall after finishing in 9th in 2005.
