### **Organization**

The Committee consists of 20 members and ex-officio members, two new members were added to the Committee this year and three meetings were held.

### **Officials**

Clinics: This year we conducted nineteen training clinics, (see attached list for sites and dates) and **297 attendees**. This is most likely the highest attendance at PVS Clinics in many years or ever.

### **Other Activities**

The Committee continues to provide PVS shirts to officials after two years of working meets. This has been extremely popular and you will see many officials in their shirts at meets. We continue to provide Bells to new starters, also a popular item

The Committee carefully reviewed and established a protocol for dive over starts this year. On August 28<sup>th</sup> the Officials Committee by a large but not full majority endorsed the concept and established a sub-committee to write up the procedure. The proposal was presented to the Competition Committee on September 24<sup>th</sup> and the Committee endorsed the proposal. On September 27<sup>th</sup> the PVS Board reviewed and endorsed the procedure. The concept was presented at the PVS Referees Clinic on September 30<sup>th</sup>. By all reports the procedure has been implanted very successfully in almost all meets this season.

We sent two "new referees" to the Officials Training Workshop conducted by USA Swimming in Colorado Springs, May 28-30, 2006. Jim Thompson and Tim Husson represented PVS.

Committee member Jim Thompson continues to refine and improve an Excel Spreadsheet to allow the Meet Referee from each PVS sanctioned meet to capture the names of each Official who worked, the Meet, actual session(s) and position (s) worked. Final data for this season and a description of the process for capturing and analyzing data is attached.

Officials Chair Jim Van Erden will attend the USA Swimming Officials Chair's annual meeting in San Antonio on June 14-16, 2007.



### **Status Update on Officials Tracking**

### **Background**

Starting in the 2004-2005 season, the Officials Committee undertook the task of developing. Figure 1 illustrates the original process that involved collecting data submitted through an Excel spreadsheet and accumulated in an Access database.



**Figure 1 Initial Data Collection Process** 

From the data collected, several types of reports can be produced. Here is an example list of the types of reports:

- Summary of staffing level at particular meets
- Detailed listing of positions filled at a meet
- Top ten working officials
- Summary of sessions worked by officials

Since the inception, several changes were made to the process. These changes are illustrated in Figure 2 on the next page. The changes include:

- Email notification to PVS on collection of meet data to support the Board decision to provide a \$20 refund to club hosting a meet who provide officials roster data
- Merging meet entry data with officials staffing data

With the meet entry data it is now possible to compare by club the officials staffing support and entries for meets.

For the 2006-2007 season, data were collected for 44 out of the 58 meets sanctioned by PVS and held through May 20, 2007. These include open meets, club sponsored meets, dual and tri-meets and PVS championship meets. This represents just over 75% coverage of meets.
