

In accordance with Article 8.7.2.A of our by-laws, I offer the following safety report for 2003:

1. In 2003, PVS had 5 injuries reported. This represented less than 1% of the total injuries reported to US SWIMMING for 2003.
2. In the first quarter of 2004, PVS has had 1 reported injury. Again this represents less than 1% of the total injuries reported to US SWIMMING for the first quarter of 2004.
3. NV Pools is now offering STSC classes through an agreement with PVS.
