	IMPORTANT: The above date is the deadline for clubs to submit their entries to the Meet Director. Therefore, clubs usually set an earlier deadline to receive entries from their swimmers. Check with your club for this information.
SCHEDULE	Warm-Up 4:30 PM – Events at 5:15 PM
	Meet Director reserves the right to adjust times/sessions after entries are received.
ELIGIBILITY	Open to all registered Potomac Valley Swimmers. Registered swimmers from out of town teams are also permitted. Swimmers shall compete at the age attained on the first day of the meet.
	The meet is limited to 275 swimmers. Priority will be given to those teams who contact us in advance of the deadline to confirm team attendance with projected number of swimmers.
DISABILITY SWIMMERS	<ul> <li>PVS and host clubs along with their meet directors are committed to the Inclusion Policy as adopted by the PVS BOD. Athletes with a disability are welcomed and are asked to provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to competition.</li> </ul>
TIMING SYSTEM	Colorado Timing System semi-automatic (buttons) and manual timing (Stopwatches) will be used for this meet

RULES	Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet.
	No on-deck USA-S registration is permitted
	• Deck entries must be submitted with payment (\$10.00 per event) no later than 30 minutes prior to the first event. No new heats will be created.
	• In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (i.e., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.
	Deck changes are prohibited.
	<ul> <li>Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.</li> </ul>
	Dive-over starts will NOT be used at this meet.
	• The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.
EVENT RULES	All events are timed finals.
	A swimmer may enter no more than four (4) individual events.
POSITIVE CHECK IN	The 500 Freestyle will be a positive check-in event. Swimmers for the 500 are responsible for their own timer and counter. If necessary we will run two courses for the 500 only. Check-in times for events 29-30-31-32 will be at 7:00 PM
WARM-UP	The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director may determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.
SUPERVISION	Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and cleaning up for their team areas.
SEEDING	Standard seeding will be used
