ELIGIBILITY	 Open to all swimmers of teams that are members of the Eastern States Senior Circuit. All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming, Inc. PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR ATHLETES ARE REGISTERED FOR 2019 BEFORE ENTERING THEM. There are no qualifying times but all teams agree to bring swimmers who are training at a senior level and are preparing for successful qualification or participation in Sectionals and Nationals. Please see published Circuit Guidelines for more information. Age on January 5, 2019 will determine age for the entire meet. To be eligible to enter this meet, a swimmer must be registered with USA Swimming, Inc. no later than the entry deadline shown below.
DISABILITY SWIMMERS	 PVS and host clubs along with their meet directors are committed to the Inclusion Policy as adopted by the PVS BOD. Athletes with a disability are welcomed and are asked to provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to competition.
TIMING SYSTEM	Automatic timing (touch pads primary) will be used for this meet.
RULES	Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet.
	No on-deck USA-S registration is permitted.
	 In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (i.e., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.
	Deck changes are prohibited.
	 Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
	 Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
	Dive-over starts will be used at this meet.
EVENT RULES	All events are timed finals.
	• There will be a Jr Circuit on Saturday, between the 1st and 2nd sessions for 11-14 year old athletes looking to improve or qualify for IMX events.
POSITIVE CHECK IN	All Relay check in must be done by the end of warm up for each session.
	Saturday- Check-in for the 400 IM will be by 8:00 am
	Saturday- Check-in for the 500 Free will be by 9:00 am
	• Check in for the 1000/1650 Free will be by 6:00 pm on Saturday.
WARM-UP	The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director may determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.
SUPERVISION	Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and cleaning up for their team areas.
SEEDING	 All events at the distance of 200 and below will be pre-seeded. All relays, 400 IM, 500 Free, and 1000/1650 Free will be deck seeded and require a positive check in.

SCORING	This meet will not be scored.		
AWARDS	There are no awards at this meet.		
PROGRAMS	Meet programs will be available for spectators at each session for \$2.00.		
CREDENTIALS	rents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not rmitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be rmitted on the deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming embership with them at all times.		
SPECTATOR ENTRY FEE	There will be no spectator entry fee.		
OFFICIALS	• Each participating club is requested to provide at least one table worker or official (Referee Starter, Chief Judge or Stoke & Turn Judge) per session if entering 25 or more splashes.		
	 Officials available to assist with the meet should volunteer in advance by contacting Phyllis Cuttino, <u>pcuttino@me.com</u> 		
	 Officials volunteering for this meet should sign in at the recording table prior to the start of warm-ups. Certified officials who have not previously volunteered should contact the referee upon arrival to make their services available. A comprehensive officials briefing will precede each session during warm-ups. 		
TIMERS	 Participating clubs are requested to provide timers in proportion to their entries. One timer is requested for each 25 entries. 		
ENTRY PROCEDURES	Entries should be submitted by email to the Meet Director.		
	• Include in the subject of the email, "2019 Senior Circuit #3 - ****" with the club's initials in place of the asterisks. If your club submits multiple entry files include training site in the subject of the email.		
	• Include in entry email: entry file, report of entries by name, report of entries by event.		
	In the body of your email provide entry numbers (girls, boys, totals), contact information (email, phone, officials contact).		
	Entries directly from individual team members will not be accepted.		
	• Entries by phone or fax will not be accepted.		
	 The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director. 		
	 Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100 by PVS and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine is paid.
