Local Protocols and Requirements

All local and state protocols will be followed per <u>Moving Virginia Forward – Phase 3 Guidance</u>. This guidance includes:

- Face coverings required
- Fitness and Exercise establishments open at 75% capacity
- Indoor and outdoor swimming pools may be open at up to 75% occupancy, if applicable, provided ten feet of physical distance may be maintained between patrons not of the same household.
- The total number of attendees (including both participants and spectators) of recreational sports cannot exceed the lesser of 50% of the occupancy load on the certificate of occupancy, if applicable, or 250 persons
- 10' spacing on pool deck and spectator area between persons who are not members of the same household
- Health screening prior to entry

Spectator Ingress and Egress

 Spectators will not be allowed. However, athlete/coach/official/timer entrance will be through the main building and up the stairs, through the door that leads directly to the pool deck. All participants will exit directly from the pool deck.

Safe Sport Considerations

In compliance with Safe Sport, parents will have access to and the opportunity to observe their child. The meet will be live-streamed to The FISH's Facebook feed.

Meet Specific COVID-19 Protocols

- Athletes must arrive and depart in their suits. Locker room use must be minimized. Restrooms will be available for emergency situations with occupancy limited to one person at a time.
- Athletes must wear masks while not in the water warming up, cooling down, or racing.
- Coaches, officials, volunteers, and spectators must wear masks at all times.
- All attendees will be required to complete a health attestation in addition to the completing the Sparrow
 Occupational Health Screening tool (https://www.sparrow.org/OccHealthScreening) no more than four (4) hours
 before entry into the facility. A coach or marshal will be stationed at the entry point to screen swimmers and
 volunteers for completion of the survey. No swimmer will be allowed entry after 7:05 a.m. and no volunteers will be
 allowed entry after 7:35 a.m.
- Swimmers will be assigned a space on deck and non-family members will be spaced 10' apart. Swimmers will receive their deck space assignments prior to arrival to the meet.
- Entry and Exit will be through separate doors. Entrance is through the building and up the stairs, exit is through the outdoor pool entrance.
- No Spectators will be permitted. The meet will be live streamed to the FISH's Facebook page.
- We request that all attendees notify the meet director as soon as possible if they have tested positive for COVID-19, shown symptoms or have been in contact with anyone exposed to COVID-19 after attending the meet.
