The competition course has been certified in accordance with current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 104.2.2(C). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.

Locker room use will be for emergency use only and will be cleaned between each use by the St. James. All attendees (athletes, coaches, volunteers, officials, etc.) must wear masks, with the exception of athletes when warming up, cooling down, and competing. All attendees (athletes, coaches, volunteers, officials, etc.) will submit to a health screening and temperature check before they are permitted in the facility. Non-members of The St. James must complete the St. James Self-Health Assessment and Participation Terms & Conditions no earlier than 12 hours before attending (specify STJ Swimming Rental as "Sport"). Each session will be limited to 80 swimmers. Only swimmers, coaches, meet volunteers, and officials will be permitted on the pool deck. Swimmers will wear their masks until they arrive at their lane and they will take it off and hang it on the hook on the starting block. Swimmers will immediately put their masks back on at the completion of their swims before they leave the bulkhead.

	Swimmers must follow all directions as posted and adhere to all marshal directions.
	• Swimmers will walk around the pool deck and line back up in the designated area with proper social distancing until they are cleared to go up the stairs back to their seated area.
	<ul> <li>All swimmers must remain in their designated area for their group until they are called for their event and they must return to their area immediately following their event.</li> </ul>
	Swimmers may not enter another swimmer's "square" of seating.
	<ul> <li>Any swimmer not following the meet protocols will be subject to immediate removal from the meet.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>All coaches, officials, and volunteers must bring their own water bottle and snacks. Hospitality is not permitted per the facility.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>We request that all attendees notify the meet director as soon as possible if they have tested positive for COVID-19, shown symptoms or have been in contact with anyone exposed to COVID19 after attending the meet.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>No spectators will be permitted. Competition will be live-streamed via the St. James Swimming Facebook page (https://www.facebook.com/stjswimming) and by Machine Aquatics.</li> </ul>
RULES	• Current USA Swimming rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), shall govern this meet.
	No on-deck USA-S registration is permitted.
	• In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.
	Deck changes are prohibited.
	<ul> <li>Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.</li> </ul>
	Dive-over starts will not be used at this meet.
	<ul> <li>The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 &amp; U events per Rule 205.3.1F.</li> </ul>
	No deck entries will be accepted.
EVENT RULES	All events are timed finals.
	All events are open age group and mixed gender.
	<ul> <li>400 IM &amp; 500 Freestyle will have no more than 4 heats. Swimmers who are removed from the 400 IM or 500 Freestyle will be given the opportunity to select another event.</li> </ul>
	• Swimmers may enter up to three (3) events per day.
POSITIVE CHECK IN	All events will be pre-seeded.
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WARM-UP	The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director may determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.	
	• Warm Up will be assigned per group to ensure no more than 5 swimmers per lane for warm -up.	
SUPERVISION	Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and cleaning up for their team areas.	
SEEDING	All events will be pre-seeded.	
PROGRAMS	The meet will be available on Meet Mobile.	
CREDENTIALS	<ul> <li>Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted on the deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming membership with them at all times.</li> </ul>
