RULES	<ul> <li>Current USA Swimming rules, including the <u>Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy</u> ("MAAPP"), shall govern this meet.</li> </ul>				
	<ul> <li>No on-deck USA-S registration is permitted.</li> </ul>				
	<ul> <li>In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.</li> </ul>				
	<ul> <li>Deck changes are prohibited.</li> </ul>				
	<ul> <li>Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.</li> </ul>				
	<ul> <li>Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.</li> </ul>				
	• Dive-over starts will not be used.				
	<ul> <li>The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 &amp; Under events per Rule 205.3.1F.</li> </ul>				
	No deck entries will be accepted.				
EVENT RULES	• Athletes shall compete at the age attained on the first day of the meet. Athletes may only compete in events of his/her own age group.				
	• Events will be pre-seeded. Athletes will be notified of their individual sessions along with a heat and lane for warm-up.				
	• Athletes may enter a maximum of four (4) individual events for the meet				
	<ul> <li>Swimmers competing in the 8 and Under events (25 yds) will start from the far end of the pool.</li> </ul>				
	All events are timed finals.				
COVID-19 CONSIDERATIONS	<ul> <li>An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. 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COVID-19 PROTOCOLS	<ul> <li>Before signing up your young swimmer, please consider that they can manage themselves for the duration of the meet with just their swim coach overseeing them, including being able to visit the bathroom independently.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Athletes must arrive and depart in their suits. Locker room use will be for emergency use only and no showering or changing will be allowed.</li> </ul>
	• Athletes must shower prior to arrival at the pool.
	• All attendees (athletes, coaches, volunteers, officials, etc.) must wear masks, with the exception of athletes when warming up, cooling down, and competing.
	<ul> <li>All attendees (athletes, coaches, volunteers, officials, etc.) will submit to a health screening and temperature check before they are permitted in the facility. Non-members of The St. James must complete the <u>St. James Self-Health Assessment and Participation Terms &amp; Conditions</u> no earlier than 12 hours before attending (specify STJ Swimming Rental as "Sport"). Per CDC guidelines, individuals with a body temperature greater than 100.4 degrees will not be permitted entry into the facility. Members of the St. James may complete this via the St. James app.</li> <li>Each session will be limited to no more than 90 swimmers.</li> <li>Only swimmers, coaches, meet volunteers, and officials will be permitted on the pool deck.</li> <li>During warm-ups, swimmers will wear their masks until they arrive at their lane. They will put it in</li> </ul>
	a plastic zipper bag behind their lane. Once warm-ups are completed, swimmers will immediately put their masks back on.
	<ul> <li>During competition, swimmers will wear their masks until they arrive at their lane and they will take it off and put it in a plastic zipper bag. The zipper bag will be placed beneath their block. Swimmers will immediately put their masks back on at the completion of their swims before they leave the bulkhead.</li> </ul>
	• For the 25 yd events, which will start at the far end, the swimmers will put their masks in a plastic zipper bag. The bags will be collected by a marshal who will walk to the finish end of the race and place the masks and zippers bags behind the lanes for the swimmer. Upon completion of the race swimmers will retrieve their masks and immediately put their masks back on.
	<ul> <li>Swimmers must follow all directions as posted and adhere to all marshal directions.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Swimmers seated in the stands will enter the pool deck through the stairwell on the shallow end of the pool. They will return to their assigned area via the same stairwell. Volunteers will ensure one- way traffic on the stairwell at all times. Swimmers seated in the splash park area will access the competition area while walking against the "scoreboard" wall and merge into the staging area by walking behind the turn end of the competition pool. Upon completion of their race, upon leaving the bulkhead, swimmers will return to the splash park area while walking against the scoreboard wall. The marshal at the end of the bulkhead will ensure that there are no swimmers walking in both directions at the scoreboard wall.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Swimmers will walk around the pool deck and line back up in the designated area with proper social distancing until they are cleared to go up the stairs back to their seated area or walk back against the scoreboard wall to the splash area seating.</li> </ul>
	• All swimmers must remain in their designated area for their group until they are called for their

	event and they must return to their area immediately following their event.		
	<ul> <li>Swimmers may not enter another swimmer's "square" of seating.</li> </ul>		
	<ul> <li>Any swimmer not following the meet protocols will be subject to immediate removal from the meet.</li> </ul>		
	• All coaches, officials, and volunteers must bring their own water bottle and snacks. Hospitality is not permitted per the facility.		
	<ul> <li>We request that all attendees notify the meet director as soon as possible if they have tested positive for COVID-19, shown symptoms or have been in contact with anyone exposed to COVID- 19 after attending the meet.</li> </ul>		
	No spectators will be permitted. The meet will be live-streamed on the Patuxent Aquatics Club Facebook Page.		
POSITIVE CHECK IN	<ul> <li>All events will be pre-seeded. Swimmers unavailable to participate in the meet should contact the meet director as soon as they are aware of their absence.</li> </ul>		
WARM-UP	<ul> <li>The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director may determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.</li> </ul>		
	• No more than five (5) swimmers per lane.		
SUPERVISION	• Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and cleaning up for their team areas. Each team MUST assign a certified Coach to remain in the assigned Team Area at ALL times to ensure COVID-19 guidelines are being followed and to assist with Clerk of Course.		
	<ul> <li>No spectators will be permitted in the facility. Swimmers and coaches may not bring personal chairs.</li> </ul>		
SEEDING	All events will be pre-seeded.

CREDENTIALS	<ul> <li>Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted on the deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming membership with them at all times.</li> </ul>		
OFFICIALS	<ul> <li>Officials will be identified in advance by Cherlynn Venit (<u>dpws@aol.com</u>).</li> </ul>		
	Walk-on officials cannot be accommodated.		
	• Officials volunteering for this meet should sign in at the recording table prior to the start of warm- ups.		
	• A comprehensive officials' briefing will take place on the evening of Friday, March 5, 2021.		
TIMERS	One timer per lane. There will be two Head Timers.		
	• Clubs will be required to provide timers in proportion to the number of swimmers they have entered in each session.		
	• The number of timers required per club and their lane assignments will be emailed no later than Monday, March 1, 2021 and will also be emailed to the contact person of each team.

	<ul> <li>Include in the subject of the email, "2021 PAC Penguin Mini Champs Meet - ****" with the club's initials in place of the asterisks. If your club submits multiple entry files, please note as such in your entry.</li> </ul>		
	• Include in entry email: entry file, report of entries by name, report of entries by event.		
	<ul> <li>In the body of your email provide entry numbers (girls, boys, totals), contact information (email, phone, officials contact).</li> </ul>		
	<ul> <li>Entries directly from individual team members will not be accepted.</li> </ul>		
	• Entries by phone or fax will not be accepted.		
	<ul> <li>The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director (<u>dpws@aol.com</u>).</li> </ul>		
	• Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100 by PVS and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine is paid.
