	• The pool at the Takoma Aquatic Center is a 50m x 25yd pool with two moveable bulkheads. Competition will be held in 8 lanes, 25 yards, running wall to wall.
	• Water depth range of 7' (lane 1) to 13.5' (lane 8) at the starting end and at the turning end.
	The meet hosts will ensure the required course dimensions.
ENTRY	Thursday, October 9 <sup>th</sup> at 11:59 pm
DEADLINE	IMPORTANT: The above date is the deadline for clubs to submit their entries to the Meet Director. Therefore, clubs usually set an earlier deadline to receive entries from their swimmers. Check with your club for this information.

	*Note: Meet Manager will determine if session start times will need to be adjusted or if age groups need to be moved to different sessions based on the number of entries received. A timeline will be established and forwarded to each team by Wednesday, October 15 <sup>th</sup> .
ELIGIBILITY	Open to all registered Potomac Valley Swimmers.
	• No swimmer will be permitted to compete in the meet unless the swimmer is registered as an athlete member of USA Swimming as provided in <i>USA Swimming Rules and Regulations</i> , Article 302.
SWIMMERS WITH A DISABILITY	<ul> <li>PVS and host clubs along with their Meet Directors are committed to the <u>Inclusion Policy</u> as adopted by the PVS BOD. Athletes with a disability are welcomed and are asked to provide advance written notice of desired accommodations/modifications to the Meet Director and Meet Referee. The athlete (or athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the Session Referee in writing of any desired accommodation/modifications prior to competition.</li> <li>Athletes requiring special accommodation are asked to complete the form below.</li> </ul> NECESSARY ACCOMMODATIONS FORM
TIMING SYSTEM	Automatic timing (touchpads primary) will be used.
MEDICAL ASSISTANCE	Medical assistance will be provided by the facility staff. If you require medical assistance, please notify a facility lifeguard or a member of the meet staff.

RULES	Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet.
	All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
	No on-deck USA Swimming registration is permitted.
	• In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, restrooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.
	Deck changes are prohibited.
	Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
	Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
	Dive-over starts will be used.
	The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.
EVENT RULES	All events are timed finals.
	All events will be pre-seeded except the 400 IM and 500 Freestyle.
	Athletes may swim a maximum of six (6) events for the meet and no more than three (3) events per day.
	<ul> <li>No deck entries will be accepted.</li> <li>The 500 Freestyle and 400 IM are bring your own timer events. Swimmers must provide their own timer and lap counter (500 Freestyle) for those events.</li> </ul>
POSITIVE CHECK IN	Positive Check in will be used to seed the 400 IM and 500 Freestyle events
WARM-UP	The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director will determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.
SUPERVISION	Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and for cleaning up their team areas.
SEEDING	Spectators will be permitted in the facility.
SEEDING	<ul> <li>Standard seeding will be used.</li> <li>The 400 IM and 500 Freestyle will be seeded Fastest to Slowest.</li> </ul>

	Entries by phone or fax will not be accepted.		
	The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director.		
	• Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100 by PVS and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine is paid.
