	All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.		
	No on-deck USA Swimming registration is permitted.		
	• In compliance with <i>USA Swimming Rules and Regulations</i> , the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, restrooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.		
	Deck changes are prohibited.		
	 Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as be proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without t use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. 		
	Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.		
	Dive-over starts will not be used.		
	• The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.		
EVENT RULES	All events are timed finals.		
	 A swimmer may enter no more than four (4) individual events. No deck entries will be accepted. 		
POSITIVE CHECK IN	All events will be pre-seeded.		
WARM-UP	The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director will determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.		
SUPERVISION	• Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and for cleaning up their team areas.		
SEEDING	 Spectators will be permitted in the facility. Standard seeding will be used. 		
SCORING	Standard Seeding will be dised. N/A		
AWARDS	 Ribbons will be awarded for Individual Events 1st – 8th place. For 10 & Under events, awards will be split out for 1st - 8th place for 8 & Under and 9-10 age groups. 		
PROGRAMS	Meet programs will be emailed to teams and available on Meet Mobile.		
CREDENTIALS	Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted on the deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming membership with them.
